

SENIOR PLAYER CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

In addition to BC Netball's General Code of Behaviour, you must meet the following requirements with regard to your conduct during any activity held by or under the auspices of Netball BC.

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators.*
- 2. Treat everyone with respect including team-mates, coaches, opponents, event organisers and spectators.*
- 3. Accept with dignity the decisions of officials.*
- 4. Be generous in winning and graceful in losing.*
- 5. Refrain from conduct which could be regarded as sexual or any other harassment.*
- 6. Conduct yourself in a responsible manner relating to language, temper and punctuality.*
- 7. Refrain from the use of foul language and remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability.*
- 8. Refrain from the use of force outside the rules of the game.*
- 9. Maintain a high standard of personal behaviour at all times.*
- 10. Abide by the rules and respect the decisions of the umpires. Be courteous and use the correct process when seeking a rule clarification.*
- 11. Play within the rules and the spirit of the rules of the game at all times.*
- 12. Refrain from using information technology to make or post inappropriate comments against team players, opponents, team officials or game officials which are discriminatory or offensive. Information technology includes but is not limited to email, instant messaging, text messages, phone messages, digital messages, website posting (including social media such as facebook, twitter and blogs).*
